500ADAT Firmware v1.40 Update Process

Mac

Please note: There are separate firmware updater applications for Intel and Arm processors.

The firmware updater application works on Mac OS 13 & 14.

- 1. When the "Apple cannot check it for malicious software" pops up, click ok.
- 2. On Mac OS, go to "System & Settings" then "Privacy & Security" scroll down to "Security" it will say "Cranborne Firmware Updater was blocked from use because it is not from an identified developer", click "Open Anyway"
- 3. Follow the "500ADAT Firmware Updater Application" instructions below.

Windows

The firmware updater application works on Windows 10 & 11.


- 1. Uninstall the "Cranborne Audio FirmwareUpdate Driverv5.50".
- 2. Run the "Cranborne Audio 500ADAT Firmware Update Driver Setup".
- 3. When "Windows protected your PC" pops up click "More info" then "Run anyway"
- 4. Follow the "500ADAT Firmware Updater Application" instructions below.
- 5. Restart the PC.

500ADAT Firmware Updater Application


The following instructions are the same for both Mac and Windows.

First, connect your 500ADAT to your PC/MAC.


Run the "Cranborne Audio 500ADAT Firmware Updater_v1.40", it should look like the following:



Ensure the Firmware menu says 1.40



Click "Update"



Wait until the firmware update has finished, it will look like the image below, note "Current Firmware: 1.40" is now displayed in the Connected Device menu.



Click Finish to quit the application.
